When the Son of man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on his glorious throne. On January 11, 2004 Fr. Benedict Groeschel, founder of the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal, a well-known author, EWTN host and respected Catholic psychologist, was struck by a car while crossing the street in busy downtown Orlando, Florida. In the hours, days, and weeks that followed, Fr. Benedict nearly died three times. Today, 6 years later, at the age of 77, Fr. Benedict reflects upon the Church's teaching on the afterlife and offers the unique insights of a man who has seen death and lived to tell the story.
