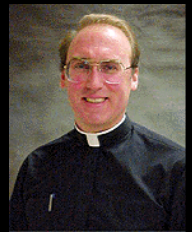
## **CREATION OR EVOLUTION WHAT DOES THE CHURCH REALLY TEACH?**
