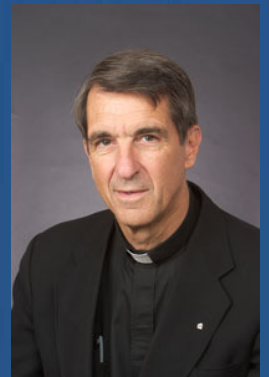
THE POPE THE ANGLICANS & THE MASS

On November 4, 2009, Pope Benedict XVI, seeking to end the 500 year schism with the church of England, signed the Apostolic Constitution *Anglicanorum Coetibus*. With this declaration, Pope Benedict XVI boldly opened the doors of the Church to all Anglicans who seek full and visible communion with the Catholic Church. Rome awaits their response.

Father Joseph Fessio, SJ was ordained as a Roman Catholic priest on June 10, 1972. In 1975, he earned his doctorate in Theology from the University of Regensburg, West Germany having studied under Fr. Joseph Ratzinger, now Pope Benedict XVI. In 1978 Fr. Fessio founded Ignatius Press, a Catholic publishing company well-known for its dedication to publishing trustworthy Catholic literature and the primary publisher of Pope Benedicts many books. Fr. Fessio is an internationally recognized lecturer on topics related to the Liturgy and Pope Benedict XVI. Join Fr.
